SKILLET CORN CHOWDER

Yield: 4 Servings | Serving Size: 1 cup

Cost/serving: \$0.51

Ingredients:

- 1/2 small onion, diced
- 1 Tablespoon vegetable oil
- 1 (15-ounce) can cream style corn
- 2 cups 1% milk
- 1/2 cup reduced fat cheddar cheese, shredded

Directions:

- 1) Heat vegetable oil in a large skillet over medium heat.
- 2) Sauté onion until transparent. Add corn and milk. Stir until mixed together.
- 3) Heat until bubbles start to form.
- 4) Stir in cheese until melted. Serve once cheese has melted.

Option: This chowder can be made ahead of time because it thickens well when chilled overnight.
