# Record Book Tips - Part 4??

I forgot to put some record book tips in the last couple newsletters but I am starting it up again with Fair time right around the corner!

Here's your tips for June!

- Write neatly so books are easy to read! If you don't have the best handwriting, use a computer to type up your records
- Write in complete sentences and be specific.
- Include fun photos and newspaper clippings but remember its not a scrapbook.
- Check out your friend's and older member's record books! If you are still in your first couple years of 4-H and don't know what to do, ask questions and compare books.
- If you have multiple years in one book, put the current year first and be sure to use set dividers to not confuse yourself and interview judges.
- Now is a great time to check back on your goals that you wrote earlier. See if there's anything new you can start working on or check off goals that you have accomplished!
- Start working on the financial part of your project book. If you have livestock animals, start writing down feed costs, vaccine costs, etc. If you have a indoor project, be sure to write down how much you have spent on equipment, products, etc.



# Family Entry

## **Important Reminders**

- Your fair probably has dates when entry is accepted into the fair. Be sure to complete your entry (including the final "Submit" step) prior to the cut-off date.
- Recommended browsers: Google Chrome or Mozilla Firefox. Older versions of Internet Explorer may cause unexpected results.
- Register all entries for each exhibitor in the family before proceeding to the Payment section.
- Be sure to click the "Submit" button when you have completed your entries. Entries are not final until they have been submitted.
- Check your email inbox for a confirmation email with a list of your entries and any related fees.
- You will receive a second email when your entries have been approved by your fair.

## Steps

1. Go to <a href="http://www.fairentry.com">http://www.fairentry.com</a> and click "Find Your Fair".



2. Filter by your state, click Search, and then click on the correct fair.




3. Sign in with 4HOnline

You have a 4HOnline log in, click on the green button and enter it here.










#### **Creating Entries**

Each exhibitor can have multiple entries. One entry must be made for each item, animal, class, etc. For example, if an exhibitor is bringing 2 photographs, two entries into the photography class must be created. If an exhibitor is showing one horse in 5 events, five class entries must be created. Once all entries have been created for the first exhibitor, you have the choice of creating another exhibitor in this family (and entries) or proceeding to check-out (submitting the entries, whether or not fees are charged).

1. Click Add an Entry beside the correct exhibitor.




- Click Select beside the first department you wish to enter. Any departments that are not available for entry will be noted as "Not Available" with a short explanation.
- 3. After you select a department, you will see a list of divisions to select from, and then a list of available classes. Also notice that there are blue "Change" links in case you mistakenly select an incorrect department, division, or class.
- 4. You may check multiple classes in a Division at the same time!
- If this is an <u>animal class entry</u>, you will be required to specify which animal will be exhibited in this class. You will see the option to "Add animal".
- "Add animal from Scratch". Fill in all of the fields with information about the animal you intend to exhibit. Click Create and Add Animal when finished.
- If the animal information was entered incorrectly, you have the option to either Remove From Entry (creating a new animal) or Edit Animal Details. When it's correct, click Continue.









 The Review screen allows you to double check this entry for accuracy, and make any changes necessary. When the information is correct, click Continue and that class entry is complete.



- 9. When each class entry is complete, you have 3 choices for what to do next:
  - a. If all class entries have been completed for one exhibitor, you can Register another Exhibitor in this family.
  - b. If this exhibitor has more class entries to make, you can **Add another Entry for this Exhibitor**.
  - If all entries for all exhibitors in the family have been completed,
     Continue to Payment to finalize and submit your entries.
- 10. Review your entries for completeness and accuracy. Notice the Summary and Detail buttons at the top of the list on the right. If there are errors, click on the green Entries section at the top of the page. Click Continue when all information is correct.







11. There is no payment due, so click Continue



- 12. Read the information in the "After you Submit" section. You may also have to check a box to "Agree to Terms". Click Submit to finalize the entries for the exhibitors in this family.
- 13. After you click Submit, no changes are possible to these entries.
- 14. Enter all exhibitors before you click Submit.
