

GRANITE COUNTY GOVERNMENT STUDY COMMISSION FINAL REPORT

To the Citizens of Granite County:

The Granite County Study Commission elected by the voters on November 8, 1994, or thereafter appointed present this final report to the citizens of this county.

The purpose of the study commission, as defined in state law, is "to study the existing forms and powers of our county government and procedures for delivery of local government services and compare them with other forms available under the laws of the state". If some change is deemed necessary, the study commission may submit such proposed change to the electors.

In the conduct of their review the study commission has sought advice and information from a number of people in the county. Opinions and recommendations were solicited from local government officials and citizens. All meetings of the study commission were open to the public. Public hearings were held to determine citizens opinion.

As a result of discussions held with the people mentioned the Granite County Study Commission has concluded that there is general consensus that the existing county commission form of government has served this county well since its organization in 1893, and will continue to do so in the future. We therefore recommend no change in this form of government.
