The following should be included in your narrative: Your Name, Age, Club, how long you have been in 4-H, why you decided to purchase this garment over the others compared, garment features (yoke, collar, cuffs, set-in sleeves, etc.), fiber content, accessories (shoes, belt, etc.), school you go to, hobbies and interests. Use descriptive words (such as short sleeves, ruffled skirt, elastic waist, etc.). 50 - 100 words total.
